Sec. 10-1. Licenses Required (2)

It shall be unlawful for any person within the city to exhibit any carnival circus, menagerie museum, collection of curiosities or show of any kind without first obtaining a license. No person shall use the streets of the city for exhibition, parade or advertising purposes without first paying a license fee and obtaining a license from the city council; provided that the city council is hereby authorized where the same is given under the auspices of a church, school, charitable institution fraternal or patriotic organization, to waive the license fees and requirements hereinafter provided for.

Sec. 10-2. License Fee- Circuses.

For circuses alone or for circuses and menagerie combined, the license fee shall be fixed by the city council at the time the application is made but in no case shall the license fee be less than one hundred dollars and not over one hundred and fifty dollars for the first day and fifteen dollars for each succeeding day.

Sec. 10-3. Same- Menageries

For menageries alone the license fee shall be; for the first day, twenty dollars, and for each succeeding day; ten

Sec. 10-4. Same- Carnivals

For carnivals, amusement devices or any aggregation of attractions or acts, not otherwise enumerated in this chapter and to which an admission fee is charged, the license fee shall be such as the city council by resolution designate.

Sec. 10-5. Same- Parade

Where exhibitions are not held within the city but the streets of the city are used for traffic parade or advertising purposes the license fee shall be such as the city council may establish by resolution.

Sec. 10-6. Issuance of Licenses

Any person desiring to obtain a license under the provisions of this chapter shall make application to the city council and if such license is granted to the applicant; he shall pay into the city treasury for the use of the city as a license fee the sum which the city council shall fix for such license; and shall receive the city auditor's receipt therefor specifying the amount paid and the purpose for which the same was paid. Upon paying the sum specified, the city auditor shall thereupon warrant and issue to the applicant a license under the official seal of the city.

Sec. 10-7. Revocation of Licenses

Every license issued under the provisions of this chapter shall be issued with the distinct understanding that such license may be revoked by the city council at any time after the issuance thereof when, if in their opinion such license is not properly conducting the business for which the license was issued.
